Resolution #2016-18 Adopting Snow Emergency Policy

A snow removal emergency is defined based upon forecast information or actual observed conditions that the accumulation of ice or snow, whether from snow fall or drifting, will necessitate snowplowing, snow removal, or winter pavement treatment operations.

The Town of Red Cedar is authorized to declare a snow emergency when the town determines that snow is causing hazardous driving conditions.

A snow emergency may be declared at any time. The Town Chairman, or his/her designee, is authorized to determine, based upon forecast information or actual observed conditions, that the accumulation of ice or snow, whether from snowfall or drifting, will reasonably necessitate snowplowing, snow removal or winter pavement treatment operations.
